

# **Catechism registration for all grades**

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW



Registration takes place after the 9.30 mass on Sunday 28th January in the Parish Centre (Hall). Please be advised that we will be having a QR code for the registration process and catechists will be on hand to answer any questions that you may be.



Classes will start from the 1st February



- Ages 3-8 Sunday mornings 9.00-10 Good Shephard catechism
- Faith Level 1 ( First Confession) This is the first year of FHC prep. - Sunday mornings - 11am - 12pm
- Faith Level 2 (First Holy Communion) 2nd year of FHC prep - Sunday mornings - 11am -12pm NB:- FL2 cannot be done unless FL1 has been completed.
- EDGE (Post FHC) Friday evenings from 6pm-8pm
- LifeTeen (Confirmation prep) Sunday evenings after 6pm mass - 8.45pm
- Confirmation (4th year) Thursday 6pm-7pm



Registrations costs R60.00 per child / R100 per family - This is to cover the costs of material and stationary that is used for teaching purposes. NB:- Catechists are volunteers and are NOT paid for their services.



We will NOT be accepting cash! Payments can be made via Card, EFT or Snapscan - If you would like to pay by cash, please put the money into a SEALED envelope with your child's name and label it for Catechitics.



You must be a registered at our parish in order for your child to be catechised here. If your child is being registered for the first time, please ensure that you have their baptism certificate in order for the registration to be finalised.
