What Does the Divine Mercy Image Mean?

The Divine Mercy image was painted under St. Faustina’s direction, depicting Christ as he appeared to her. In the picture, Jesus is dressed in white and luminous in appearance,

and he is stepping forward ever so slightly as if to come closer to us. His right hand is raised in blessing while his left hand points towards his heart, from which two rays pour forth: one white or translucent and one red. These two rays represent the blood and water that flowed from His pierced side on the cross, as Jesus himself explained: “The pale ray stands for the Water which makes souls righteous. The red ray stands for the Blood, which is the life of souls. These two rays issued forth from the very depths of My tender mercy when My agonized Heart was opened by a lance on the Cross” (*Diary of St. Faustina*, 299).
